## Fundraising 2008

As we are a small committee we need to call on our members more to help with fundraising. We are planning to hold a Cake stall outside New World on Thursday March 20<sup>th</sup> - just before the Easter long weekend. We would ask all of you to get out your favourite recipes and bake a couple of items - cakes, biscuits, muffins, slices for us to sell. Plastic plates will be available at the library to put baking on. If you do not wish to or are unable to bake we ask that you pay a \$20 fundraising fee instead. This can be paid at the library or posted to Louise Powick, Makomako Road, RD3 Pahiatua. Please pay this by the time of the cake stall to ensure you can continue to borrow from the library.

Please get behind us with your support and benefit your children. Maybe you have family members or friends who would like to support us by baking as well. That would be great!

Our other fundraising idea for the year is a sausage sizzle outside Bunnings Warehouse in Palmerston North which will be later in the year.

## Why do we fundraise???

Fundraising is vital for the library if we wish to purchase new toys. The money we receive from subs, hire age of videos/DVDs and grants is mainly directed towards the running costs of the library ie rent, power, insurance, toy library federation levy, cleaner and librarian, equipment, services, advertising etc. It costs about \$200 per member per year for us to run the library. We receive grant money and some of this is allowed to be used for buying toys but when applying for this we are always required to state what fundraising activities we are doing ourselves.

Our other option is of course to raise subs or to charge an additional hire age fee on toys as most toy libraries in the country do, but we want to try and avoid this if we can.

A copy of our receipts and payments for the 06-07 year is on the notice board in the library if anyone wishes to see it.

## A few changes

The committee met recently and decided on a few changes - as follows

### Borrowing Rules 2008

To make this a little simpler, you will now be entitled to borrow up to **four toys** and **two puzzles** per family. This will be the same for members regardless of the number of children. We feel this is fairer as we all pay the same sub.

### Annual Subscription

We have decided not to offer a six monthly membership anymore so membership will be yearly and remain at **\$60 per year/ \$35 for grandparents**. There is an option of paying this off if necessary. Please ask for a payment contract at the library.

### Blue Dot Toys

In order to try and allow new and popular toys to be more available in the library we have decided to make these "blue dot toys". They will have a blue sticker attached. You will be able to borrow one of these toys per visit.
